QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent; Mechanical knowledge with two years' experience in related field. Possess a valid Arizona driver's license, ability to pass Arizona DOT medical/physical examination and a pre-employment drug screen. Successfully complete training programs with post-training qualification period, successful completion of drug and alcohol testing, ability to be re-certified periodically on Standard Operating Procedures as well as through examination on all rules and hands-on proficiency, ability to write clear and concise reports and must be available to work weekends, holidays, evening and late night hours.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This position performs maintenance activities in support of Sun Link Streetcar. The responsibility of this classification includes tasks assigned by Leads, Supervisors and Managers to assist and perform tasks under general supervision. On the job training will be provided to perform tasks required to assist technicians. This is an entry level position in which the daily tasks will change depending upon need and will be subject to shift changes.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Performs safety and preventive maintenance inspections of vehicles, systems and equipment, documents defects, maintenance and repairs, inspects, repairs and adds ticket media for Ticket Vending Machines (TVM's), operates and maintains shop equipment and tools, works safely at railway crossings under automobile and train traffic, performs re-railing of equipment, runs for parts and supplies, performs cleaning tasks of streetcar, station stops and building, works both indoors and outdoors and in inclement weather, maintains parts inventory and computer inventory records, operates computers for documenting work performed and related tasks, maintains a safe and clean shop and work area, prepares various activity and status reports, documents defects and repairs on inspection forms, work orders, or designated computer programs, performs related work as required, must be available to work weekends, holidays, evening and late night hours, performs other duties as assigned.

BENEFITS:
