

## Public Art along the Sun Link Streetcar Route

- Public art can be found at 22 streetcar stops, the Operations & Maintenance Facility, the Luis G. Gutierrez Bridge and the Plaza Centro Parking Garage.
- 11 unique streetcar stops featuring signature public art pieces and 10 stops with LED panels with poetry provided by The University of Arizona Poetry Center with the theme of flow.
- Public art reflects our community's unique cultural identity and character.



## Selecting the Artists

- The Tucson Pima Arts Council (TPAC), the designated local arts agency for the City of Tucson and Pima County, facilitated the selection of the artists associated with the streetcar project.
- Artists for the stops were selected by a panel of local residents, artists, streetcar designers, and representatives from the City of Tucson and Regional Transportation Authority (RTA).
- The artists were selected in 2009 and brought under contract in 2010.
- The City of Tucson and Pima County's *Percent for the Arts* Program allocates 1% of the budget for capital improvement projects for public art.
- RTA policies also support the inclusion of artwork.
